

## Boys Packing List for Cub Pack 337

### Suggested Camping Supplies (R = Required):

√	<b>GEAR</b>	<b>R</b>	<b>Description</b>
	Camp Cup	√	Each Scout must bring his own camp cup. If you have lost the one the Pack gave you, or if you haven't gotten one yet, please bring one with a handle, so that it can hang with the others.
	Sleeping Bag	√	If you don't have one, you can make one with comforters, blankets, and sheets on top of a sleeping pad.
	Pillow/Blankets		Personal preference
	Camp Chair	√	One for each person to sit on during meals, and around the campfire
	Flashlight		If you like flashlights to walk around at night, bring one.
	Money	√	Camp store snacks, various trip costs. You may want to allow older boys to carry some of their own money to teach responsibility.
	Rain Gear		The rain seems to bother the parent more than the boys (thus optional)
	Other (Optional)		Watch, camera and film, sunglasses, hat, pen, musical instruments, cards, games, Two way radios

√	<b>CLOTHING</b>	<b>R</b>	<b>Description</b>
	Clothing	√	T-Shirts (Pack and other scout T's), Shorts, Pants, Socks, Underwear, Shoes, Items for the cold (if needed)
	Toiletries	√	Soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, comb, brush, washcloth, towel, tissues, T.P. (in plastic), Note, this stuff is required 'cause we don't want you boys to skink!
	Class A Uniform	√	Full scout dress uniform. This is to be worn at all flag ceremonies during the campout.
	Class B Uniform	√	A T-shirt bearing some kind of Scouting reference. Prefer Pack T-Shirt.

√	<b>PERSONAL</b>	<b>R</b>	<b>Description</b>
	Scout Book	√	Label and have a safe place for it.
	Canteen	√	Canteen or water bottle highly suggested when hikes or day events are planned. Please keep hydrated.
	Note Pad/ Pencil	√	Webelos especially should always be prepared to take notes.
	Religious Material	√	A Scout is reverent. Be sure your boy brings a Bible or other religious material to read/study.
	Rope	√	All cubs Wolf and above should have a rope to practice knots.
	Whistle		Safety whistle is optional, but later required as a Boy Scout.
	Pocket Knife		Boys MUST have and carry a Whittling Chit card with them. See your leader for details. Sharpeners can be a lot of fun for the boys to bring as well.
	Fun Stuff		Light sticks, Frisbees, balls
